Saturday morning, April 28, you will have the choice of touring several historic sites in Quincy or attending a lecture -- "Col. Grant in Illinois" -- presented by **John Alexander**, owner of *Books on the Square* in Virden and Springfield. The Historical Society will provide a shuttle from the History Museum (332 Maine Street) to the Governor John Wood Mansion campus (425 South 12th Street) approximately every 20 minutes. Attractions available at the John Wood Mansion campus include the Governor John Wood Mansion, Lincoln Gallery, 1832 Log Cabin, and Livery.

Other historic sites open that day include the Dr. Richard Eells House, 415 Jersey, and the Lincoln-Douglas Debate Interpretive Center, 128 North 5th Street. These sites are within walking distance of the History Museum, and transportation to these locations will be available only in case of inclement weather.
